- Visit the park and the beach. Explore the local area and spot both natural and man made features.

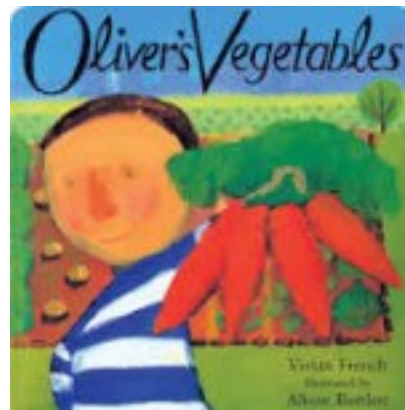
King Charles Class

Science: Plants

We are continuing to look at the seasons and seasonal changes.

We will be answering the questions:

What are the parts of a plant called?

Which type of compost grow the tallest sunflowers?

What are wild plants?

What are common plants?

What makes a tree?

Which tree has the biggest leaves?

We will learn how to use a key to identify plants.
